FullCase provides the tools and resources necessary to automate and improve your daily operation from the beginning. Here is how it works:

- Cases that are on file with the Court (active and closed) are preloaded into the FullCase database from the Court's FullCourt® or FullCourt Enterprise™ system.
- All Parties (*i.e.*, suspects, defendants, victims, witnesses, *etc.*) from the FullCourt or FullCourt Enterprise system will be preloaded into the FullCase database. The attorney's office begins with a populated database of frequent offenders, victims, witness, *etc.*
- Track cases from the entry point to your office to the final disposition of the case without having to locate the physical case file. FullCase provides quick access to information on a case or report, including full exhibit tracking, without the physical case file/report in front of you.
- Generate virtually any document used by an attorney's office. FullCase has a library of over 200 commonly used documents from prosecutor and public defender offices across the U.S.
- Print documents singularly by case or in batch (groups) by date such as subpoenas for all witnesses and officers testifying in cases set for a specific date or date range.
- Save generated documents or use the FullCase Imaging module to scan and store documents at the case level.
